



Representative Bivins: Bad for Missouri

2007 and 2008 Votes

Representative Bivins voted FOR the following bills:

- HB 444, HA 6 (2/14/07) Voted to give tax cuts to Missourians making more than \$100,000 per year.
- HB 353 (2/8/07) Voted to allow fraudulent health care providers to participate in the Medicaid Program.
- HB 620: (3/8/07) Voted to allow uncertified teachers to educate Missouri children (Missouri educators opposed this bill).
- SCS HCS HB 12; (5/10/07) Voted to increase personal office expense accounts while voting against restoring
HB 39, HA 5: (2/12/07) healthcare for more than 100,000 elderly, disabled, and children. (2 separate votes).
- HB 686: (3/15/07) Voted to lessen regulations on nursing home administrators.
- HB 1371, HA 1 HSA 1
HA 1 (2/26/08) Voted to prevent small businesses from receiving tax credits for moving to rural communities.
- HCS SCS SB 901,
HA 1 HAS 1 HA 1 (5/8/08) Voted to cut the benefits of disabled workers.
- HCS HB 1779 (3/6/08) Voted for a 100% tax increase on phone service.
- HCS SCS SBs 1181, 1100,
1262 & 1263 (5/15/08) Voted for a tax increase on Natural gas.
- HCS SS SCS
SBs 818 & 795 (5/16/08) Voted to allow adults to use internet services to harass children.
- HA 5 (5/14/08) Voted to allow Jefferson City bureaucrats to override local regulations on health and safety ordinances.

Representative Bivins voted AGAINST the following bills:

- SB 577, HA 15 (5/11/07) Voted against restoring health care for more than 100,000 elderly, disabled and children.
- HB 444, HA 2 (2/14/07) Voted against allowing certain retirees with private pensions to receive a tax cut on their pension benefits.
- HB 353, HA 1 to HA 2: (2/6/07) Voted against paying Missouri medical providers the average national rate.
- HB 39, HA 4 (2/12/07) Voted against allowing health benefits for working disabled Missourians.
- HB 189, HA 2 (2/15/07) Voted against allowing law enforcement officers to use deadly force in certain situations where fear of imminent danger is present.
- HB 40, HA 3 (2/26/07) Voted against giving a tax credit for monies spent on long term care insurance policies.
- HB 620, HA 1 & 2 (3/5/07) Voted against requiring Missouri teachers to be evaluated (Missouri educators supported this measure).
- HB 453, HA 6 (2/7/07) Voted against requiring employers who receive state assistance to provide health insurance for their employees.
- SB 284, HA 7: (3/14/07) Voted against requiring the cable companies to provide consumers with the name, address and phone number where a complaint can be filed or a dispute can be resolved.
- HB 2, HA 4 (3/27/07) Voted against funding early childhood education
- HB 5, HA 4 (3/27/07) Voted against restoring the 2005 health care cuts
- HB 6, HA 2 (3/28/07) Voted against increasing funding for Veterans Homes
- HB 10, HA 9 (3/28/07) Voted to shortchange the people that take care of our disabled and veterans
- HB 12, HA 2 (3/28/07) Voted to strip worker's rights
- HB 12, HA 3 (3/28/07) Voted to increase their own per diem, while decreasing funding for pediatrician in home care
- HB 12, HA 4 (3/28/07) Voted to increase legislative staff while decreasing funding for nursing home safety
- SCS HCS HB 1,
HA 3 (8/23/08) Voted to approve a tax credit for millionaire developer Paul McKee.
- HCS HB 2393,
HA 4 (4/15/08)
(PAGE 2 OF 3) Voted to give tax credits to firms that outsource Missouri jobs.

HCS HB 2011, HA 3 (3/26/08)	Voted against restoring healthcare for nearly 100,000 Missourians.
HCS HB 2011, HA4 (3/26/08)	Voted against a promise to return dental and vision care 30,000 Missourians.
SB 1038, HA 1 (5/16/08)	Voted to allow elected officials to raise unlimited amounts of money in the capitol and governor's mansion.
HCS SB 830, HA 1 (4/30/08)	Voted against helping Gulf War veterans get a college education.
SS HCS HBs 1549, 1771, 1395 & 2366 (5/15/08)	Voted against punishing employers who hire illegal immigrants.
HCS HB 2011, HA 10 (3/26/08)	Voted against funding for schools working to help mentally ill children.
HCS HB 2002, HA 2 (3/25/08)	Voted against a program that protects students in the classroom.
Sub. Motion on SCS HCS HB 2009 (4/21/08)	Voted not to give corrections workers payment they earned.
